- Scholars will be allowed to enter the building beginning at 7am

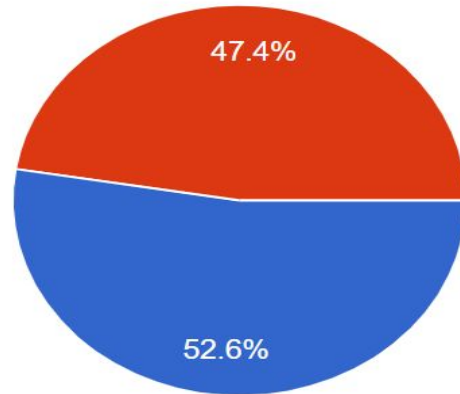

# Attendance

## **In Person**

Attendance will be determined by physical presence in the building.

Attendance to be recorded daily for AM and PM

On Wednesdays, students are expected to engage in distance learning. And attendance will be counted from assignments submitted virtually.

## **Virtual**

We encourage families to ensure that their scholar attends their virtual schedule.

Attendance will be determined the same as in Quarter 1.

10 Assignments is perfect attendance for the week.

# Grading

Grades will be determined by student mastery of content.

Students who are in person and virtual should be present for ***all*** learning activities to ensure that they are learning the necessary content.

# Safety Protocols

- Students and staff will wear masks
- Hand sanitizer dispensers in each classroom
- Windows for airflow
- HVAC retrofits for air quality
- Merv filters
- Desk shields for teachers

# Cleaning, Sanitizing and Disinfecting

- The custodial staff will be cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting regularly
- Teachers will be supporting cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting efforts and teaching students to engage in hygienic behaviors

# Student Supply List

## All Students

- Mask
- CKLA workbooks & Eureka's Fluency (yellow) and Learn (blue)
- Water bottle
- Paper (to be left in the classroom)
- Other classroom-specific items
- Chromebook and charger (except PK and K)

## Pre-K

- Blanket
- Mats (keep in plastic, we will unwrap and put names)
- Snacks

# Chromebook

Scholars in Grades 1-5 will bring their chromebook to school daily.

Chromebooks and chargers should be transported in a bag to prevent damage

Chromebooks not transported properly may not be returned to the scholar

Chromebooks that are damaged will need to be repaired by TPS and will not be replaced

# Supplies Provided by GLA

- Pencils
- Pens
- Student Erasers
- Storage bags
- Hand sanitizer
- Face shields (Grades PK - 1)



# Supplies cont.

Students should limit items brought to school (outside of supplies listed and coats). We will refrain from sending items home as much as possible.

# Scholar Arrival

School Hours for Scholars: 7:30am - 3:11pm

Doors open for students at 7am

Families should take student temperatures at home and ensure students feel well before bringing them to school

If TPS permits, we will take temperatures of all students before entering the building. Staff will be present in the parking lot to take temperatures

Families should not let students out of the car or leave until scholars have been cleared to enter the building

# Scholar Arrival cont.

If a scholar has a temperature over 100 degrees, the scholar will not be permitted into school for the day and should not return until symptoms have normalized

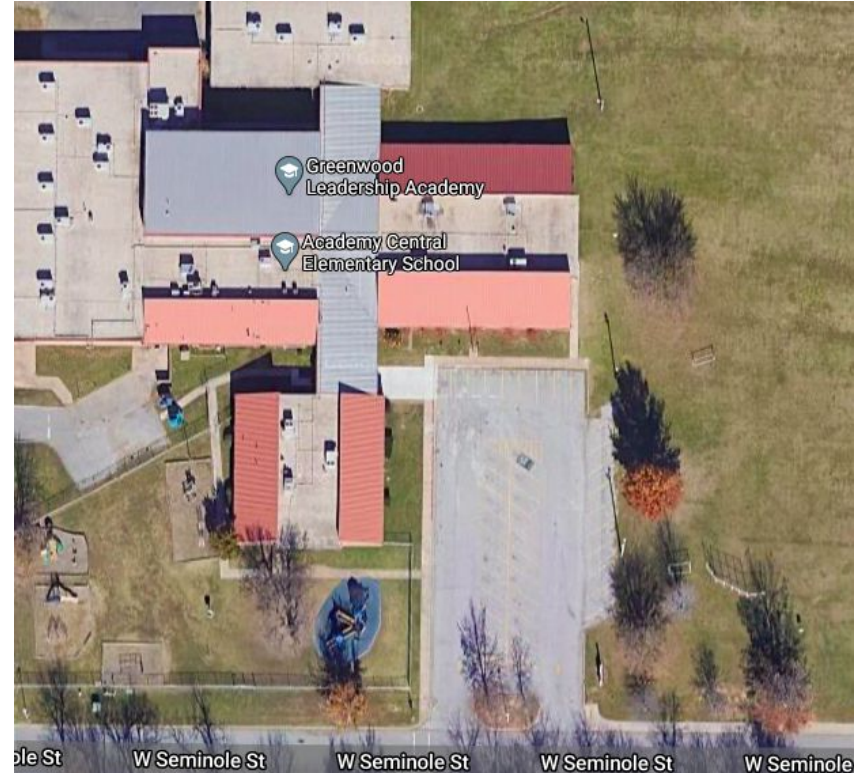
Families are not permitted in the building in order to limit contact in the building. A staff member will collect and direct your scholar from your vehicle.

# Arrival (Drop-off)

Students will be welcomed into the building beginning at 7am - we cannot accept students earlier than 7am

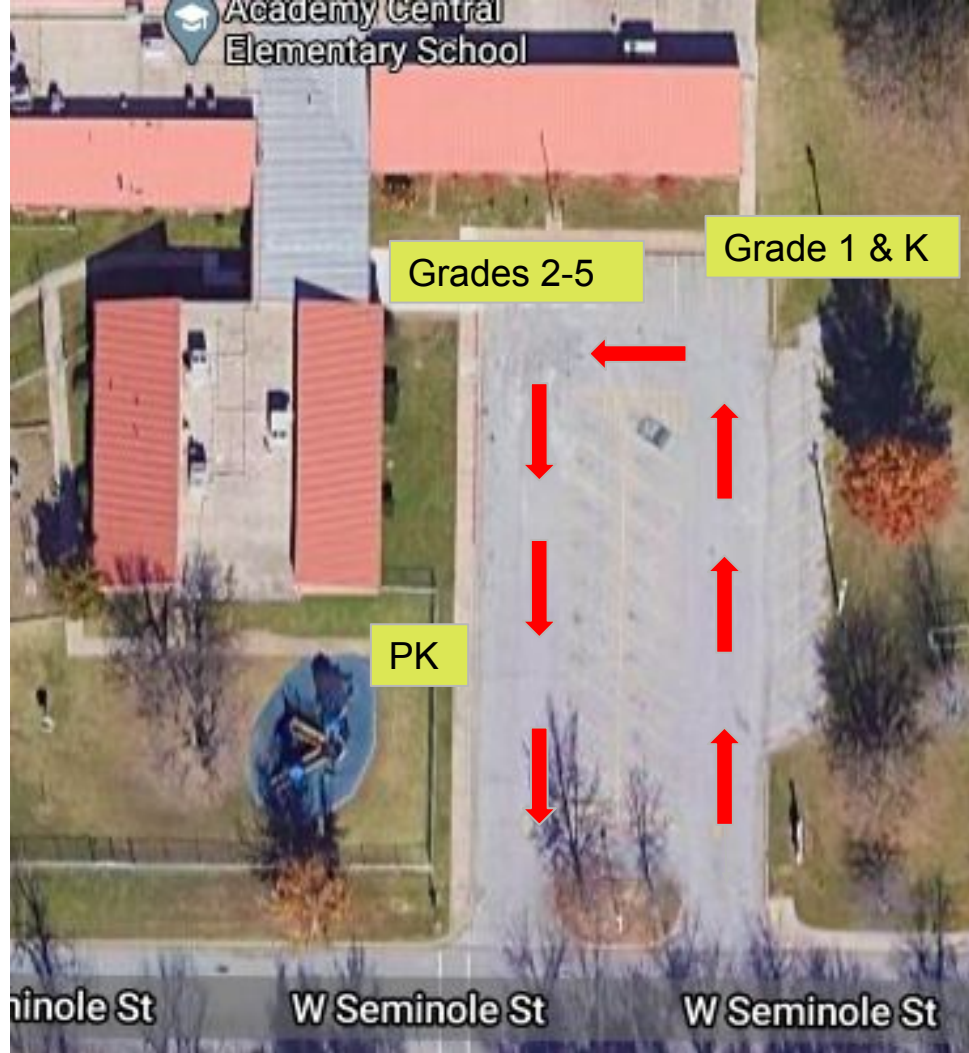
Families who drop their scholars off can access our parking lot on W Seminole Street

Students and families are to stay in their vehicle until a staff member collects and directs the student



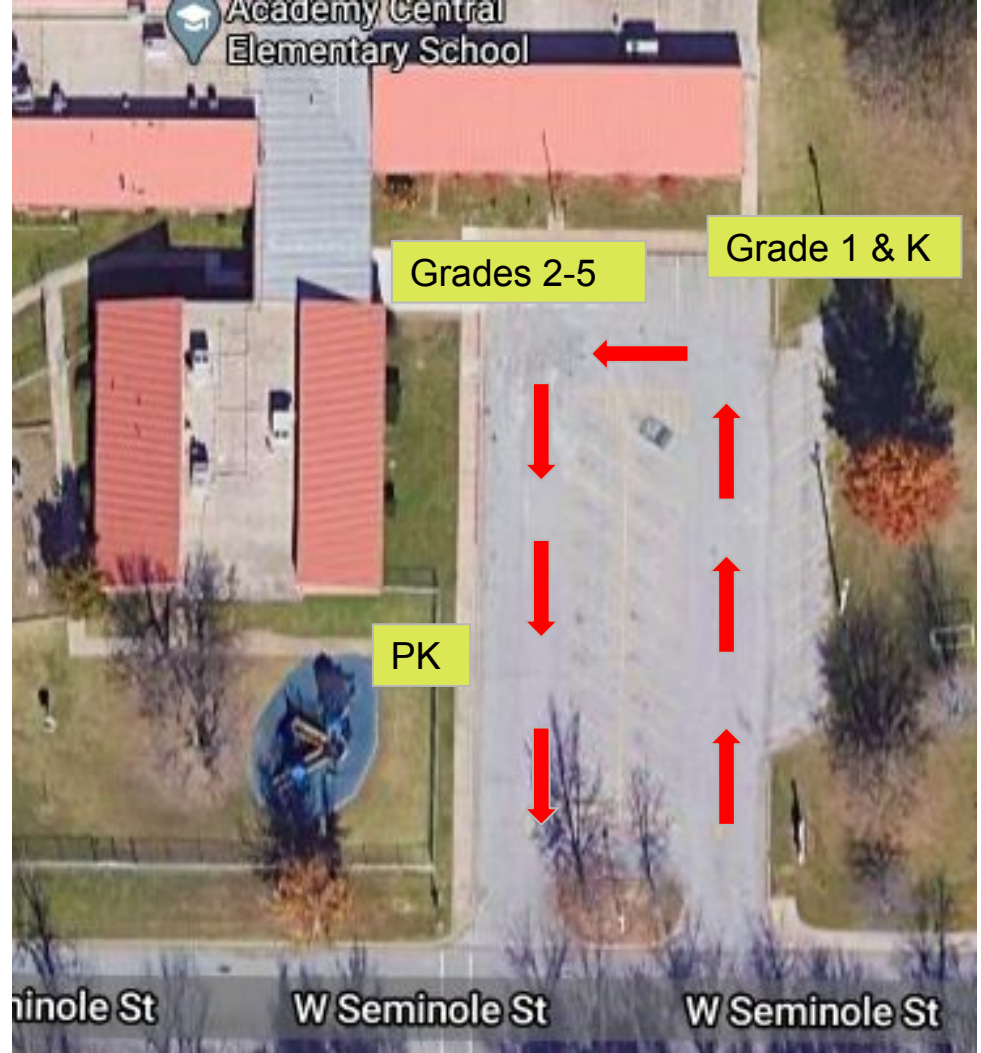
# Arrival cont.

Why is this decision  
being made?

We know that we can  
best serve scholars in  
our building.

Many families need  
support with learning  
and are ready to get  
back in the building.

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What time is in-person  
learning?

School hours are 7:30 - 3:11

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What time is drop-off?

Drop-off begins at 7am.

Scholars may NOT be  
dropped off prior to 7am.

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What time is virtual learning?

7:30am - 3:11pm

Most of this time will be with the teacher, but some time will be independent learning.

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Will scholars have class  
on Wednesday?

All students will be virtual  
on Wednesdays

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How will the ESS  
teacher provide  
support?

The ESS teacher will provide  
in the modality in which the  
student is engaged

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# When do families need to commit to in-person vs. virtual learning?

Surveys must be completed by tomorrow, October 30.

If you completed the TPS survey, you still **MUST** complete the GLA survey.

Failure to complete the survey will automatically opt the scholar into distance learning.

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# Can I switch my learning mode?

We are asking families to commit to a learning mode for the duration of Q2 to limit disruptions to learning and the structures.

Requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis.

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How will scholars  
social distance?

Scholars will remain  
6ft apart when  
possible. The number  
of scholars returning  
to in-person learning  
will impact our ability  
to keep scholars  
physically distant.

Will scholars wear  
masks?

Yes, all scholars will wear masks all day with breaks when possible.

Breaks occur during lunch and when outside.

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# Will scholars wear uniforms?

GLA will have a relaxed dress code policy:

- Mask\*
- Navy or white polo
- Pants, slacks or skirts for young ladies (jeans are permitted)
- Close-toed shoes

\*Face shields may be worn in addition to masks, not in place of masks

# What happens if a scholar refuses to wear a mask?

Wearing a mask is mandatory. Scholars who refuse to wear a mask will be receive disciplinary action.

Scholars who receive consistent disciplinary actions for mask infractions may lose in-person learning privileges.

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# Will we take temperatures?

TPS is not taking scholar  
temperatures.

GLA plans to take scholar  
temperatures.

Scholars with elevated  
temperatures will not be  
permitted into the  
building.

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Will scholars receive  
breakfast?

Scholars will be eligible  
receive THREE (3) meals  
per day.

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What happens if a scholar gets sick at school?

The scholar would be quarantined in the building and the family would be contacted to pick-up the student

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What if someone  
contracts COVID-19 or  
comes in close contact?

We would initiate contact  
tracing to determine the  
need for quarantine.

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What safety  
precautions will there  
be on the bus?

Students must wear masks on the bus.

Students below Grade 1 will need to have an adult pick them up from the bus stop

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Will this be the only  
option for the rest of  
the year?

This is the option for Quarter  
2. We will observe the  
climate, data and gather  
information to make good  
decisions for the remainder  
of the year
